What is the 12th CDS Meeting?

The 12th Cognitive Development Society Meeting brings together researchers and scientists from the many disciplines comprising the world of Cognitive Development. The conference serves as an important event for discussion and exchange of the most cuttingedge knowledge, insights, issues and ideas in our field.

The first Cognitive Development Society Meeting was in Chapel Hill, North Carolina in 1999. The conference has continued to grow and move throughout the US. The 11th Bi-Ennial Meeting in Louisville, KY attracted over 800 delegates.

Who is organizing the conference?

The 12th Cognitive Development Society Meeting is being organized under the leadership of the CDS Melissa Koenig (University of Minnesota) with support from the Board of Directors and the Program Committee.

The Program Committee is led by Kristina Olson (Princeton University).

The overall conference planning process is organized by CDS and the team at Podium Conference Specialists.

Who attends the conference?

The conference draws principal investigators, postdoctoral fellows and grad students actively engaged in cognitive development studies.
